NEW BUSINESS

A. WRV HS Family and Consumer Science Equipment Requests

As you know, I normally give each principal a \$10,000 budget for repairs/updates during the summer months. With a change in the administration during this summer, I would like to move the high school's \$10,000 to the FACS department for the renovation of the kitchens. We have had most of the high school departments come in for some upgrades; it is now FACS's turn. Mrs. Misner has done a great job with writing Perkins grant monies through Twin Rivers for small updates, but the time has come for her to do some small renovations that require a little more than Perkins' funds. Perkins' fund monies have been cut as part of the Federal grant program. Mr. DeMoss will be doing the work in-house, so the monies will be spent for supplies and materials. Just like I have the principals do each August, we will have Mrs. Misner report back to you and possibly host a meeting in her department at the end of the summer.

Mr. Hostetter made a motion to use the High School principal's \$10,000 to renovate the FACS's kitchens. The motion was seconded by Mr. Davis. The motion passed 7-0.

C. WRV Middle School Entrance and WRV High school Safety Entrance

Earlier we talked about examining our safety entrances. I am asking for permission tonight to seek quotes for a wall to separate the MS main entrance to the main corridor and a new door entrance into the office from that corridor. This will force anyone who enters the main entrance of the building to go directly into the office upon entrance into the building. I am having Mr. DeMoss draw up plans to be able to execute the building portion/safety changes during the first two weeks of June at the MS. I am awaiting a plan from Mr. DeMoss to set up the same safety precautions at the high school. We have had discussions already and he is seeking an extension to the main entrance to allow for a safety barrier before anyone can enter the high school corridor. Following his work at the middle school, I would like Mr. DeMoss to work in late June and July on finishing the issue.

Mr. Decker made a motion to give Dr. Hacker permission to get quotes for the front entrances at the Middle School and High School. The motion was seconded by Mr. Shake. The motion passed 7-0.

D. WRV Elementary Fire Alarm System Proposal and PA/Bell Proposal

Two of the remaining items on our pre-referendum facility update list were the necessary replacement of the fire alarm system and replacement of the PA/Bell System at the elementary school. These systems are at the end of their lives. Both of these are big safety issues for our students/staff. We knew that five years ago when we began the plan for replacements. I have two quotes to get each of these done. I have given you both quotes in your board packets. I am recommending the quote from Koorsens Technology Systems at a price of \$13,954 for the fire alarm system and SWC Communications for the PA/Bell System at a price of \$14,856. Both of these safety issues need to be corrected.

Mr. Hostetter made a motion to replace the Fire Alarm system with Koorens for REPLACE FIRE ALARM \$13,954 and replace the PA/Bell System with SWC Communications for \$14.856 at WRV Elementary. The motion was seconded by Mr. Davis. The motion passed 7-0.
