Last month, I gave the board information regarding a body safety academic program that was brought to me by Tracee Dixon, our health/PE teacher at the high school. The program is called Body Safety; it is a program offered to teach our students about good touch/bad touch and is done in a purely academic way, rather than slang. It is a program that we've had here before; Terry Hall, the program director, taught our student body in 2014. We are now 7 years removed and it is our school's recommendation-and mine-to bring the program in again. It would be taught during the early part of the second semester. This program is yet another tool that our kids can have to help communicate with qualified adults on a difficult topic. I would ask for permission to move forward again with this request by Mrs. Dixon. There is a cost involved, and it will be an Education Fund Expenditure.
